

## Who We Are







Samburu Lodge



# The Spear

# The Spear

Tip


Papa John and John Kellogg have functioned as the tip of the spear - initiating relationships in the rural and marginalized areas in which we are creating community.

Head

The tip is part of the head of the spear, which together represent the leadership, organization and structure developed both here and abroad.

Shaft

### **Capital Campaign Donors**


Those wishing to give larger one-time donations for specific infrastructure needs which may include: teacher scholarships, buildings, vehicles, wells, and other substantial ministry needs.

### **Advocate African Adventure Program**

BTCG will pay up to \$2,500 in airfare to Nairobi, Kenya and all program expenses\* in East Africa for a 2 week trip to visit schools and other BTCG programs in East Africa. This will include a stay at our Samburu Safari Lodge where various activities such as a camel safari, river fishing with the hippos, elephant watching and other activities will be enjoyed as well as an opportunity to visit our Samburu Mission Center and enjoy visiting with the local artisans, dancing and feasting will be held.
